By Summer Classes

Ballet Westside's Summer Program is designed to introduce the beginner to some of the ideas and concepts of the main fall/spring sessions. It also gives the more accomplished student a chance to polish his or her skills.

Ballet Westside offers three different summer sessions. You may choose one, two, or all. Sessions will run two weeks and will meet Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. The cost is \$85.00 per session for 1 hour classes or if you have multiple sessions or siblings it is discounted at \$75.00 per session. Please call me if you need a special scheduling time. Students may split up their classes between sessions to accommodate vacation plans.

Classes offered for summer sessions include Ballet, Tap, and Tumbling for preschoolers; Ballet, Tap, Jazz combo, Jazz/Hip Hop, Ballet Technique, and Tap Technique classes for intermediate and advanced students.


